After moving to Asia in 1997, Eduardo Vargas tasted success at Singapore's Coco Caribe and Brewerks, before venturing to Shanghai, where he's become something of a celeb for his work at a long list of restaurants including his own Latin-specializing Azul Tapas Lounge. Vargas has since become an international consultant to food businesses, opening over 25 restaurant concepts across Asia that showcase cuisines from Cambodian to Mexican.

Located on Hengshan Lu, Colca is a combination of South American flair and modern Shanghainese style by serial restaurateur and Peruvian national Eduardo Vargas, who also brought the city Azul and Brasa.
